

REGULATION

1. Type of the Competition ENDURO CROSS "BOBAN RODEO" RD-1

1.1 Date of the competition: 29.04.2023.

Place of the competition: Husky Moto Park, Tbilisi. Kojori Street #22

The competition is conducted on a non-public road, which is specially planned for the competition.

(logs, stones, tires, etc.)

1.2 Categories at the competition:

Expert

Hobby

2. Competition Rules

2.1 There will be three 15-minute runs on the competition, the participants (both categories) will start together, the placement of the participants in the starting places will be determined based on a result of voting. The participants must drive on the competition track for 15 minutes, the winner of the run will be the participant who has done the most number of laps during 15 minutes. Starting positions for the next run are determined based on the results of the previous run. The time between runs is defined by 30 minutes. The winner in the respective category will be determined based on the total number of laps recorded as a result of all three runs.

2.2 The participant is obliged to move along the pre-marked trajectory on the competition route. Departure from the trajectory and purposeful passing around from the competition route is penalized. In case the participant had to leave the marked trajectory, he/she is obliged to return to the competition route from the place of leaving.



Note: The form of the penalty will be determined by the judging panel and the head referee depending on the specific violation.

2.3 It is allowed for the participants to help each other During the competition,, it is forbidden to help the participant by an unauthorized person.

2.4 It is strictly forbidden to ride motorcycles on the territory out of specially arranged competition road. Otherwise, the violator will be disqualified.

2.5 The participant has the right to: to appeal the disputed issue to the chief Judge within 30 minutes after the announcement of the preliminary results,. The Chief Judge is obliged to discuss the disputed issue with the Judging Commission and the Organizing Committee before awarding.

2.6 Participants in the competition will be evaluated using the following points system:

- 20 points to the 1st 17 points to the 2nd 15 points to the 3rd 13 points to the 4th 11 points to the 5th
- 10 points to the 6th 9 points to the 7th 8 points to the 8th 7 points to the 9th 6 points to the 10th
- 5 points to the 11th 4 points to the 12th 3 points to the 13th 2 points to the 14th
- 1 point to the 15th

3. Classification of motorcycles

All types of enduro and cross motorcycles can participate in the competition. Engine capacity is not limited. Motorcycles will not be divided according to classes

4. Safety

4.1 The Participant must be equipped with the following equipment, to be allowed in the competition:

Motobot is necessary

Helmet is necessary



Gloves are necessary Glasses are necessary Chest protection is necessary Knee pads are desirable

Armrest is desirable

Note: During the competition, the rider must have a helmet belt fastened while riding a motorcycle. If the organizer or the referee notices an unfastened helmet belt, the organizer and the referee are obliged to automatically suspend the participant from the competition without explanation.

4.2 Each participant is aware of the risks associated with the competition and is responsible for their own safety, as well as that of other participants and spectators.

4.3 Spectators are obliged not to cross the territory allocated to them during the competition course and not to endanger their personal and others' health, as well as others' material property by irresponsible actions.

4.5 In case of violation of the above-mentioned list, the organizers are released from civil and criminal liability.

5. The obligations of the organizer

5.1 The organizer is obliged to properly plan the competition, taking into account the relevant environmental factors, to directly coordinate the preparatory work of the competition and during the competition.

5.2 The organizer is obliged to inform the participants in advance about the general information and risk factors related to the competition.



5.3 The organizer is obliged to: allocate a certain number of referees for the competition and ensure objective refereeing.

5.4 The organizer is obliged to predetermine and allocate place(s) for the spectators.

6. The obligations of the participant

6.1 The participant is obliged to: register for the competition according to the procedure pre-established by the organizers and submit relevant documents for registration, in case of adulthood: identity card and the license to participate in national competitions issued by the Georgian National Motorsport Federation.

In the case of minors: to appear at the registration together with the parent/guardian, bring the birth certificate or its copy, the identity card of the parent/guardian and the license to participate in national competitions issued by the Georgian National Motorsport Federation.

6.2 The participant is obliged to attend the briefing organized by the organizers, in the case of minors: to appear at the briefing together with a parent/guardian. The time and place of the briefing will be determined in advance by the organizers. The participant's appearance at the briefing will be confirmed by his/her signature.

Information regarding the competition and general risks will be provided at the briefing, the participants will once again become familiar with the competition regulations.

6.3 The participant is obliged to: appear at the starting camp 1 hour before the start of the competition, park the motorcycle in the pre-arranged motorcycle park and register with the responsible person of the motorcycle park, as a result of which the responsible person will indicate to the athlete the location of

his motorcycle. After placing the motorcycle at the starting point, it is prohibited to drive the motorcycle except during the competition and/or with the permission of the referee.

6.4 The participant is obliged to follow the instructions of the technical personnel and the organizers without a word. Otherwise, the participant will be disqualified.

6.5 Participant is prohibited from taking part in the competition while not sober.

6.6 Participant is prohibited from touching others' motorcycle.

6.7 The participant is prohibited from unsportsmanlike conduct, which is expressed in the following: using bad language, polluting the territory, deliberately damaging or delaying the opponent, arbitrarily departing on the competition route, arguing with the referee/organizer and disobeying, deliberately violating pre-established rules.

6.8 After placing the motorcycle in the starting camp, the participant is forbidden to move the motorcycle in any way except during the competition and/or with the referee's permission.

6.9 Ignoring the paragraphs listed above will result in the disqualification of the participant

7. Registration

7.1 The fee for participation in the competition amounts to 100 GEL

7.2 Registration will start according to the rules predetermined by the organizers. The participant is obliged to register on time, and the competition number is determined chronologically according to the registration. The participant must submit relevant documentation for the registration, see paragraph 6.1.



8. Recommendations

8.1 In addition to the necessary equipment, it is recommended for the participants to be equipped with other special protective equipment.

8.2 Due to the difficult competition route, which requires the full physical load of the athlete during the competition, it is recommended that the participant determine his/her personal health condition in advance and act in accordance with his/her physical data.

8.3 Due to the difficult competition road, it is recommended that the participant prepare his/her motorcycle in advance and make sure that it is in good technical condition
