## Regulations

1. Type of Competition: Georgian Championship, Enduro Discipline - Kids. Stage III

Promoter: N(N)LE Auto-Moto Club "Extreme" Location: Akhaltsikhe Date: 06.09.2025

- 1.1 The competition will be held on a closed, specially prepared course. The race track covers approximately 500 m of easy-difficulty terrain with artificial and natural obstacles, aimed at testing both motorcycle reliability and riders' skills. Any unforeseen difficulty will be considered part of the race, and no protest will be accepted for such reasons. The track must be passable in any weather conditions and suitable for children's categories.
- 2. Enduro Kids Classes:
- 2.1 Motorcycle 65cc–125cc Age: 9–14 years. Eligible participants: born between October 2010 and October 2016. Riders must be at least 9 years old and no older than 14 on the date of each stage.

Motorcycle up to 50cc Age: 5–8 years. Eligible participants: born between October 2017 and October 2020. Riders must be at least 5 years old and no older than 8 on the date of each stage.

2.2 Participants will be scored under a points system, with the total points accumulated throughout the year determining the 2025 champion. If there are different classes, scoring will be separate.

3. Race Rules: 3.1 The race consists of three 10-minute heats. All participants start together, with starting positions determined by registration order. Winners are determined by the highest number of laps completed in 10 minutes. Points awarded determine starting positions for the next heat. Final winners are determined by total points from all three heats.

Note: In case of equal laps, priority goes to the rider who crossed the finish line first. If total points are tied, preference is given to the rider with the best finish position of the day.

- 4. Penalties/Disqualification: 4.1 Late arrival at the start disqualifies the participant from that heat. Equipment check will be conducted before the start. Note: Helmet straps must be fastened while riding. Failure will result in immediate disqualification.
- 4.2 Riders must obey officials' instructions: Yellow flag: Warning; no jumps or overtaking; speed limit 15 km/h. Red flag: Stop immediately and await further instructions.
- 4.3 Riders must follow the marked route. Leaving it intentionally results in disqualification.
- 4.4 Riding outside the designated track and paddock areas is strictly prohibited.
- 4.5 Riders have 30 minutes after the race to file a written protest.
- 4.6 Participation under the influence of alcohol is prohibited disqualification.
- 4.7 Riders or team representatives (including parents/guardians) may not touch or tamper with another's motorcycle without permission disqualification.
- 4.8 Unsportsmanlike conduct by riders or representatives (including parents/guardians) championship disqualification.

- 4.9 Transponders must be returned after the race. Loss/damage €300 fine.
- 4.10 Winners must attend the award ceremony or risk result cancellation.
- 5. Motorcycle Classification: Class EY: 65cc-125cc Class EK: up to 50cc
- 6. Safety: Mandatory gear: motocross boots, goggles, helmet, gloves, chest protector, knee and elbow guards. Participants are responsible for their own and others' safety.
- 7. Promoter/Organizer Duties: Proper planning, coordination, briefing riders on risks, assigning sufficient officials, and publishing results within 2 days.
- 8. Rider Duties: Register properly, attend mandatory briefing, arrive at paddock 1 hour before start, follow officials' instructions.
- 9. Licensing/Registration: Annual or one-time license from GNMF required. Annual license covers all 3 stages. Registration is free. Available at www.motofederation.ge.
- 10. Recommendations: Additional protective gear is advised. Ensure personal fitness and motorcycle condition.
