“PAIR RACE”

Tbilisi, 2026

Moto Gymkhana “Pair Race” is an event held under the auspices of the Georgian National Motosport Federation, with the support of the Ministry of Sport, based on FIM standards, and organized by Pitstop Academy.

This competition format involves both professional and amateur riders competing either on their own motorcycles or on identical motorcycles provided for the event. The track consists of two identical parallel courses with obstacles designed specifically for the event.

After two qualifying runs, riders are paired based on results:

Best time vs Worst time. Winners advance to the next round by crossing the finish line first.

Purpose of the event:

- Improve riding skills
- Promote structured development
- Increase public interest
- Promote motorsport culture
- Encourage legal competition instead of street racing
- Identify the strongest rider

CATEGORIES:

Scooters:

Automatic transmission, any engine capacity.

Amateur:

Manual transmission motorcycles.

(Restriction: riders with licenses in Supersport/Enduro Expert or instructors are not allowed)

Absolute:

Manual transmission motorcycles, any capacity.

Cruiser:

Factory-classified cruiser motorcycles.

Requirements:

Mandatory equipment:

- Helmet
- Jacket or elbow protection

Max participants per category: 16

Minimum: 4 (otherwise category canceled)



RULES:

Start: by marshal or traffic light

Finish: crossing finish line

Penalties:

- Crossing lane / wrong trajectory → disqualification
- Unsportsmanlike behavior → disqualification
- False start twice → loss
- Cone hit → +1 sec
- Foot down → +1 sec

Motorcycle failure at start:

15 minutes allowed to fix

Championship consists of 3 stages.

Points are awarded per stage.

Points system:

1st – 20 pts

2nd – 17 pts

3rd – 15 pts

...

15th – 1 pt

Each race win gives +1 bonus point.



Tie-breaker:

Better qualification result.

Protests:

Must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes.

Top 3 riders in each category receive medals and certificates.
