



CROSS GEORGIA 2026 – SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Event Description

1.1 Event Title

Cross Georgia 2026 is a three-day hard enduro competition held in an individual format, featuring a diverse set of technical, navigational, and endurance-based race sections.

1.2 Event Date

The competition will take place on:

06–08 August 2026

1.3 Event Location

The start, finish, and administrative control locations will be announced later and published through the official communication channels of the organizer.

2. Competition Format

2.1 Race Days

The competition consists of three (3) independent race days.

Each day includes an individual GPS track, technical sections, and the corresponding finish system.

2.2 Time Limit

Each race day has a maximum duration of:

8 hours

The organizer reserves the right to adjust the time limit due to safety, weather conditions, or force majeure circumstances.



2.3 Finish System

Each race day is divided into the following finish categories:

- Bronze Finish
- Silver Finish
- Gold Finish

The finish category takes priority over points in classification.

3. Registration and Licensing

3.1 Registration

Registration is available at:

www.motofederation.ge

3.2 Registration Fees

Registration and one-time licensing fees are as follows:

- **550 GEL – until 10 July**
(event registration + one-time license)
- **750 GEL – until 31 July**
(event registration + one-time license)
- **1050 GEL – 01–04 August**
(event registration + one-time license)

3.3 Registration Deadline

Registration closes on:

04 August 2026 – 18:00

Registration is considered complete only after:

- Fully completed registration form
- Completed licensing registration



- Payment confirmation

3.4 Refund Policy (Registration & License Fees)

Refund rules:

- Registration fees are refundable only if the event is cancelled by the organizer's decision.
- In such case, the refundable amount is calculated as follows: from the total collected registration fees, all verified and already incurred organizational costs are deducted, and the remaining amount is equally distributed among registered participants.
- In all other cases, including participant withdrawal, cancellation of participation, or no-show, the registration fee is non-refundable.

4. Administrative and Technical Control

4.1 Administrative Control

The time and location of administrative control will be announced later.

Participants must present:

- Identification document
- Driving license
- Registration confirmation
- For minors: parental/guardian consent

4.2 Technical Control

Technical inspection includes:

- Visual inspection of the motorcycle
- Verification of safety compliance
- GPS device compliance check
- Mandatory equipment inspection

The organizer reserves the right to exclude any technically unfit motorcycle from participation.



5. Briefing

5.1 Mandatory Briefing

Attendance at the briefing is mandatory for all participants.

Exact time and location will be announced later.

The briefing will cover:

- Daily route
- Safety matters
- Support zones
- Refueling zones
- Time restrictions
- Special technical sections

Failure to attend may result in exclusion from the competition.

6. Start Procedure

6.1 Day 1

Starting order on Day 1 is determined by registration order.

6.2 Day 2 and Day 3

Starting order for Day 2 and Day 3 is based on the previous day's results.

6.3 Start Interval

Participants will start individually with a:

30-second interval

6.4 Late Arrival

A participant who does not appear at their assigned start time will start immediately upon arrival; however, their official time will begin from their assigned start time.



7. GPS, Support Zones and Refueling Points

7.1 GPS Track

Before each race day, participants will receive the corresponding GPS track.

7.2 Support & Refuel Zones

The locations of Support Zones and refueling points will be predefined and communicated via:

- GPS device
- Official information channels

7.3 Prohibited Assistance

External assistance on race sections is prohibited except in designated zones defined by the organizer.

8. Mandatory and Recommended Equipment

8.1 Mandatory Equipment

Participants must be equipped with:

- GPS device
- Motorcycle GPS mount
- Mobile phone
- Backup battery or power bank for GPS/phone
- Motorcycle tool kit
- Motocross/enduro boots
- Helmet
- Gloves
- Hydration system (Camelbak)
- Goggles



- Lighter or matches

8.2 Recommended Equipment

Participants are recommended to additionally carry:

- Chest protector
- Knee guards
- Elbow guards
- Rain gear
- Tow rope
- Spare tube or tire repair kit
- Spare fuel

9. Official Communications

Any changes, updates, schedules, locations, or safety instructions related to the event will be published through the official communication channels of the organizer and shall take effect immediately upon publication.

10. Final Provisions

By registering for Cross Georgia 2026, the participant confirms that they:

- Have read and understood the general regulations and supplementary rules of Cross Georgia
- Acknowledge the risks associated with the competition
- Accept full personal responsibility
- Agree to comply with decisions of the organizer and jury commission
