



REGULATIONS

1. Type of Competition:

Georgian Championship, Enduro Discipline

Stage IV

Promoter: N(N)LE Enduro Club Georgia

Location: Tbilisi

Date: 04.10.2026

The competition is held on a non-public road specially prepared for the event. The course includes approximately 1 km of medium-difficulty terrain with artificial obstacles, aimed at testing both motorcycle reliability and rider endurance. Any unforeseen difficulty is considered part of the competition and cannot be subject to complaint.

The course must be passable in all weather conditions and suitable for Expert, Moderate, and Hobby classes.

Classes:

- Expert Class
- Moderate Class
- Hobby Class

Participants will be evaluated using a points system. The total accumulated points throughout the year will determine the 2026 winner. Points are awarded separately in each category. Only the Expert class winner will receive the title of 2026 Georgian Champion. Intermediate and Hobby class winners will receive the status of 2026 category winners.

2. Competition Rules

The competition consists of three 20-minute races (+1 lap). All participants start together. Starting positions are determined by registration order.

The winner of each race is the rider who completes the highest number of laps within 20 minutes. Points are awarded accordingly and determine starting positions for the next race. Each completed race gives +1 point.

Break between races: 30 minutes.



Final results are based on total accumulated points from all three races.

In case of equal laps, priority is given to the rider who crosses the finish line first.

In case of equal total points, priority is given to the rider with better results during the day.

If equal points remain at season level, priority is given to the rider with better results in the final stage.

3. Penalties / Disqualification

Late arrival at the start results in exclusion from that race.

Helmet must always be fastened while riding. Violation results in immediate disqualification.

Yellow flag: warning, no overtaking or jumping, max speed 30 km/h.

Red flag: stop immediately and wait for instructions.

False start:

- First offense: restart

- Second offense: loss of round

Leaving the marked track leads to disqualification unless returning from the same point.

Participants may assist each other. External assistance results in a 2-point penalty.

Riding outside designated areas leads to disqualification.

Complaints must be submitted within 30 minutes after the race.

Participation under influence is prohibited (disqualification).

Unsportsmanlike behavior leads to championship disqualification.

Failure to return the transponder results in a 300 EUR fine.



4. Motorcycle Classification

All types of enduro and motocross motorcycles are allowed. Engine capacity is not restricted.

5. Safety

Mandatory gear:

- Boots
- Helmet
- Goggles
- Gloves
- Chest protector
- Knee guards
- Elbow guards

Participants are responsible for safety.

Spectators must remain in designated areas.

Organizers are not liable in case of rule violations.

6. Organizer Responsibilities

- Proper planning and coordination
- Inform participants of risks
- Provide officials and fair judging
- Allocate spectator areas
- Publish results within 2 days

7. Participant Responsibilities

- Complete registration and provide documents
- Attend briefing (mandatory)
- Arrive 1 hour before event start



- Follow officials' instructions
- Attend award ceremony

8. Licensing and Registration

Participants must hold a valid license issued by the Georgian National Motorcycling Federation.

- One-time license: 50 GEL
- Annual license: 200 GEL
