



Regulations

1. Type of Competition:

Georgian National Championship, Enduro Discipline

Stage II

Promoter: Telavi Extreme Sports Club (Non-profit)

Location: Telavi Motopark

Date: 06.07.2025

1.1 The race takes place on a non-public road specially arranged for the event. The competition track includes approximately 2 km of medium-difficulty terrain with both natural and artificial obstacles, designed to test both motorcycle reliability and rider endurance. Unexpected difficulties are considered part of the event and are not grounds for protest. The track must be passable in any weather and suitable for **Expert**, **Moderate**, and **Hobby** class riders.

2. Enduro Discipline Classes:

-) **Expert Class**
-) **Moderate Class**
-) **Hobby Class**

2.2 Riders earn points at each stage. The total points accumulated during the year determine the 2025 champion in each category.

2.3 Winners of the **Hobby** and **Moderate** classes must advance to a higher class the following year. Hobby class winners must move to Moderate, and Moderate class winners to Expert.



3. Race Rules:

3.1 The event consists of **three 20-minute (+1 lap) runs**. All categories start together. Starting positions are based on registration order.

The winner is the rider with the most laps completed in 20 minutes.

Points from each run determine starting positions for the next.

The interval between runs is 30 minutes.

Overall winners are determined by the total points from all three runs.

Note:

-) If riders complete the same number of laps, the one who finishes first wins.
-) If multiple riders have the same total points, the one with the best single run position is ranked higher.

4. Penalties/Disqualification:

4.1 Late to the start = no participation in that run. Gear will be checked at the start.

Note: Riders must keep their helmet straps fastened while riding. An unfastened helmet results in immediate disqualification.

4.2 Riders must obey flag rules:

-) **Yellow flag:** Warning. No jumps or overtakes. Max speed 30 km/h.
-) **Red flag:** Extreme condition. Stop and await marshal instructions.

Violations result in disqualification.

4.3 False start:

-) First offense: Warning and restart.
-) Second offense: Treated as a run loss.

4.4 Leaving the marked track without reason = disqualification. If forced off, riders must re-enter at the exit point.

4.5 Riders may help each other. External help = 2-point deduction.

4.6 Riding outside the designated track/motopark area is strictly prohibited and results in disqualification.



4.7 Riders may submit a protest in writing within **30 minutes after the race**. It must be reviewed before the award ceremony.

4.8 Grounds for disqualification include:

-) Participating under the influence of substances
-) Touching or manipulating another's motorcycle without permission
-) Unsportsmanlike conduct: profanity, littering, intentional obstruction or damage, arguing with officials, intentional rule violations.

5. Motorcycle Classification:

5.1 All types of Enduro and Cross motorcycles are allowed. Engine size is not restricted. No sub-classification by bike type.

6. Safety:

6.1 Mandatory gear:

-) Motocross boots
-) Goggles
-) Helmet
-) Gloves
-) Chest protector
-) Knee guards
-) Elbow guards

6.2 Each rider accepts the risks and is responsible for their own and others' safety.

6.3 Spectators must stay in designated areas and avoid dangerous behavior.

6.4 Violating safety rules relieves the promoter/organizer of civil or criminal liability.

7. Promoter/Organizer Responsibilities:

7.1 Plan the event properly, coordinate preparation and execution.

7.2 Inform participants in advance about the race and its risks.



7.3 Provide an adequate number of officials and ensure fair judging.

7.4 Allocate designated spectator zones.

7.5 Publish official results no later than **2 days after the event**.

8. Rider Responsibilities:

8.1 Complete official registration with appropriate documents:

-) Adults: ID + National Motorsport Federation license
-) Minors: Parent/guardian must register them with ID and birth certificate

8.2 Attend the mandatory **briefing**. Attendance is confirmed by signature. Minors must attend with a parent/guardian.

8.3 Arrive at the paddock **1 hour before the race**, park in the designated area, and complete check-in.

8.4 Follow official instructions without question. Failure results in disqualification.

9. Licensing/Registration:

9.1 All riders must have either a **one-time (€50)** or **annual (€200)** license from the Georgian Motorsport Federation. Register at www.motofederation.ge

9.2 **Race registration fee: €100** via the same website.

9.3 Riders must register on time to receive a race number. Required documents are listed under point 6.1.

10. Recommendations:

10.1 Use additional protective equipment if possible.

10.2 Riders should evaluate their physical health beforehand.

10.3 Ensure motorcycles are technically sound before the race.
