



Regulations

1. Type of Competition:

Georgian National Championship – Enduro Kids Stage II

Promoter: Telavi Extreme Sports Club (Non-Profit)

Location: Telavi Motopark

Date: 06.07.2025

1.1 The event takes place on a non-public road, specifically prepared for the competition. The track is approx. 500 meters, with easy difficulty terrain, featuring artificial and natural obstacles. It is designed to test both motorcycle reliability and the rider's skills.

Any unforeseen challenges are considered part of the race and cannot be grounds for protest.

The track must be rideable in all weather conditions and suitable for the children's category.

2. Enduro Kids Classes:

2.1 65cc–125cc Class

) Age: 9–14 years

) Eligibility: Riders born between October 2010 and October 2016

- Must be at least 9 and not older than 14 by the date of the event.

50cc Class

) Age: 5–8 years

) Eligibility: Riders born between October 2017 and October 2020

- Must be at least 5 and not older than 8 by the event date.

2.2 Riders are evaluated using a points system, and total points across all stages determine the 2025 winner.

If multiple classes are held, scoring is calculated separately for each.

3. Race Rules:

3.1 The competition consists of three 10-minute runs. All participants start together. Starting positions are based on registration order. Winners are those who complete the most laps in the 10-minute time frame. Points earned in each run also determine start positions for the next run. The overall winner is determined by the total points across all three runs.

Note:

-) In the event of a tie in laps, the rider who crossed the finish line first is ranked higher.
-) If total points are tied, the rider with the best position in a single run that day gets priority.

4. Penalties/Disqualification:

4.1 Late arrival at the start = cannot compete in that run. Gear will be inspected at the start. Helmet straps must be fastened at all times. Violation results in automatic disqualification.

4.2 Flag Rules:

-) Yellow flag: Warning. No jumps or overtaking. Max speed: 15 km/h.
-) Red flag: Emergency. Stop vehicle and await marshal's instruction.

Violations = disqualification.

4.3 Riders must follow the designated course. Leaving it intentionally = disqualification. If forced off course, return at the exit point.



4.4 Riding outside the designated race/motopark area is strictly prohibited. Violation = disqualification.

4.5 Protests must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes after the race.
Judges and the race director must review them before the award ceremony.

4.6 Prohibited: Participating while under the influence. Penalty = disqualification from the stage.

4.7 Prohibited for riders, team members, or guardians: touching or manipulating others' motorcycles without permission. Penalty = disqualification.

4.8 Unsportsmanlike behavior (by rider, team, or guardian) such as profanity, littering, deliberate obstruction or damage, unauthorized course entry, or arguing with officials = championship disqualification.

5. Motorcycle Classification:

-) Class EY: 65cc to 125cc
 -) Class EK: Up to 50cc
- All types of Enduro and Cross motorcycles are allowed.

6. Safety Requirements:

6.1 Mandatory gear:

-) Motocross boots
-) Goggles
-) Helmet
-) Gloves
-) Chest protector
-) Knee pads
-) Elbow pads

6.2 Each rider acknowledges the risks and is responsible for their own and others' safety, including spectators.

6.3 Spectators must stay in designated areas and not engage in dangerous or disruptive behavior.

6.4 In case of violations, organizers are not legally responsible (civil or criminal liability).



7. Promoter/Organizer Responsibilities:

- 7.1 Ensure proper planning and coordination of the event.
- 7.2 Inform participants in advance about general information and risks.
- 7.3 Provide enough officials for objective judging.
- 7.4 Allocate areas for spectators in advance.
- 7.5 Publish official results within 2 days of the event.

8. Rider Responsibilities:

8.1 Complete registration with required documents:

-) For adults: ID and a valid competition license from the Georgian National Motorsport Federation.
-) For minors: Parent/guardian must register the child, providing:
 - o Child's birth certificate
 - o Parent's ID
 - o Valid competition license from the Federation

8.2 Attend the mandatory briefing. Confirmation by signature.

Minors must attend with their guardian, who must also sign.

Failure to attend = disqualification.

8.3 Arrive 1 hour before race start at the paddock, park in the designated area, and check in with the official.

8.4 Riders must comply fully with officials' instructions. Non-compliance = disqualification.

9. Licensing & Registration:

9.1 Every rider must have a one-time or annual license from the Georgian National Motorsport Federation.

-) One-time license must be acquired before each stage.
-) Annual license allows participation in all three stages.

9.2 Event registration is free.

All registration is done via the official website.



9.3 Registration starts at a pre-announced time.

Riders must register on time to receive their race number.

(Required documents: see Section 8.1)

10. Recommendations:

10.1 Riders are encouraged to use additional protective gear beyond what is required.

10.2 Given the physical demand, riders should assess their health condition before the race.

10.3 Ensure motorcycles are technically ready in advance.
